B. GTIC SCOPE AND PURPOSE

The Global Technical Interactions Committee (GTIC) shall be responsible for harnessing the technical resources of ASHRAE to influence international standards and maximize the global impacts of ASHRAE standards, guidelines, and other technical work products on the practice of HVAC&R and the built environment. This includes developing, implementing, and managing processes that enable information flow and coordination between chapters, technical committees, standard project committees, and international technical advisory groups. This committee shall inform the ASHRAE leadership and membership of the potential impacts of the activities and making recommendations on new activities and policies in response.

- 4. <u>Approval Of Minutes Of 21 January 2024 Hybrid Winter Meeting</u> Approval of the minutes was deferred to a future meeting.

5. Subcommittee Reports

- A. Region and Chapters Interactions Subcommittee Eleazar Rivera (chair), Hassan Younes (vice chair), Cheng Wee Leong, Jyotirmay Mathur, Fabio Clavijo, TL Chen, Ashish Rakheja, Henry Yeo (consultant) Eleazar continues to work on action items and has started contacting chapters in regions and identified requirements such as Standard 62.1. Meetings have been scheduled where the team will continue to present GTIC scope and purpose. Fabio stated since December of last year, there has been development of the HVAC code to comply with Energy code for HVAC industry in Colombia.
- B. Technical Committees Interactions Subcommittee Kevin Mercer (chair), Jon Rajala, Drake Erbe, Olu Soluade. Drake reviewed meeting minutes from Chicago along with closing out action items. See below. Kevin/TCIS has developed MBOs and provided report attached. Drake reviewed liaison reports. Eleazar will provide a list of those who are currently working with AASA.

Project Committees Interactions Subcommittee Doug Fick (chair), Steve Bushby, George Pantelidis, Drake Erbe The PCIS MBOs, report, and Strategic Plan Updates were reviewed; the report has been uploaded to Basecamp. The ASHRAE/ISO Matrix was presented, and Kai will upload the file to Basecamp as a live working document. Fabio asked what is the best way to present ourselves (GTIC) to government agencies? Eleazar suggests presenting an official letter signed by ASHRAE/GTIC Chair. Duane Jonlin asked to be added as a subcommittee member to PCIS.
- 6. <u>Liaison Reports</u> EPB Center Energy Performance Buildings Supports European directives. Roadmap document posted on Basecamp.

7. Status of MBOs

- A. Establishment of Communications Paths to TAC (Technical Activities Committee) and Standards Committee. Reviewed.
- 8. International/Region Updates. Fabio stated for RCIS, President Elect training for Region 12 is in May where the team will bring President Elect up to speed on GTIC's activities and ask to assist with continued participation and awareness. The Leaders' meeting continues to promote GTIC. Drake brought up the need to address a formal subcommittee membership process; Ryan stated that interested parties can request appointment and just need the GTIC Chair's approval. Drake has received the official invitation for ISO/TC 163 and ISO/TC 205 to meet in Paris the week of September 30th to October 4th, 2024. All subcommittees/working groups of ISO/TC 163 and ISO/TC 205 are expected to meet, along with the meetings of the joint working group and a JWG workshop.

An MOU was announced in Chicago between ASHRAE and Emirates Central Cooling Systems Corporation (Empower) to develop a district cooling standard to be adopted by various countries with emerging district cooling infrastructure. Refer to links below for more detail:
