B. GTIC SCOPE AND PURPOSE

The Global Technical Interactions Committee (GTIC) shall be responsible for harnessing the technical resources of ASHRAE to influence international standards and maximize the global impacts of ASHRAE standards, guidelines, and other technical work products on the practice of HVAC&R and the built environment. This includes developing, implementing, and managing processes that enable information flow and coordination between chapters, technical committees, standard project committees, and international technical advisory groups. This committee shall inform the ASHRAE leadership and membership of the potential impacts of the activities and making recommendations on new activities and policies in response.

5. Subcommittee Reports

- A. Region and Chapters Interactions Subcommittee Eleazar Rivera (chair), Hassan Younes (vice chair), Cheng Wee Leong, Jyotirmay Mathur, Fabio Clavijo, TL Chen, Ashish Rakheja, Henry Yeo (consultant) Eleazar survey for Chapters and members was sent out May 13 and staff will follow up on reminder options for survey. Eleazar also presented in Chile. Fabio met with the Minister of Energy in Colombia and introduced activities of GTIC and sent letter over to the Minister. Fabio to send the letter and information over to staff for feedback. A presentation was developed for the Minister and Olu provided feedback.
- B. Technical Committees Interactions Subcommittee Kevin Mercer (chair), Jon Rajala, Drake Erbe, Olu Soluade Kevin requested that both Drake and Steve speak at the TC Chair Breakfast on how TAC can better support GTIC and what is needed from the technical committees. Drake/Steve can provide more information on the ISO TAG structure for better understanding. Once the results from the survey are available, Kevin can connect RCIS with the correct TCs. TCIS will be able to identify areas for ASHRAE support on an international level at MTG in Indianapolis. Satheesh will become TAC Vice-Chair and GTIC member in July.

C. Project Committees Interactions Subcommittee – Doug Fick (chair), Steve Bushby, George Pantelidis, Drake Erbe – Discussed TC and PC Chair Breakfast plans. Reviewed ISO/ASHRAE standards matrix and added a new "Group" column to matrix to help identify next steps for standards. Report attached.



6. Liaison Reports

- A. Government Affairs Committee George Pantelidis Global Affairs Subcommittee met last week. MBO #7 is to work with committees to coordinate efforts of technical publications to become global. Region 13 delivered a spreadsheet consisting of countries and their local publications of standards and codes. This is the format that they'd like to maintain and will produce for each region and committee. Eleazar had a meeting with the upcoming Chair of GAC and Eleazar is to be Chair of Global Affairs Subcommittee.

- C. Energy Performance of Buildings Jaap Hogeling Drake Directive (EU) 2024/1275 of the European Parliament and of the Council document (attached) is now available. This declaration focuses on emissions and moving to electric. The ISO 52000 series will need to be updated by the joint working group to comply with the declaration. ISO/TC 163 to work on modeling. Kevin suggests mentioning this declaration at the TC breakfast. Steve will speak of declaration at a high level. It addresses global standardization, harmonization, decarbonization.
