Pioneers of the Industry award

The Honors & Awards committee is wondering why there is little interest in nominating deceased industry pioneers for this new award. There are many individuals that could be recognized, considering the rich heritage our industry has that is centuries old. Who in your region has been an outstanding contributor to HVAC&R engineering and industry? Study the history of our industry, identify those pioneers, do some research and nominate them. You can do it as an individual or through the Historical Committee. Here are some more details.

This award honors deceased individuals who have made milestone contributions to the growth of air conditioning, heating, refrigeration and ventilation. Individuals inducted into the Pioneers of the Industry must have shown evidence of distinction, either technically or academically. The nominee need not have been a member of ASHVE, ASRE, ASHAE or ASRAE, and this award was created to provide recognition for pioneers not eligible for the ASHRAE Hall of Fame award because they were never members of the Society or lived before the Society existed.

- Recognition is given to the recipient's accomplishments on the ASHRAE website and a permanent binder in the ASHRAE Headquarters Library.
- Maximum of two may be awarded per year
- Completed Pioneers of the Industry Nomination Form to be submitted by December 1
- Nomination can be submitted by any ASHRAE member or committee.
